I am in receipt of your letter dated June 7, 2021, which I RECEIVED on July 16, 2021.

In that letter you state that I must pay the additional amount of \$1,803.11 for some error on my 2020 tax return which you state is a repayment of my recovery rebate credit. Curiously, that is the same amount as my Covid relief payments, so I am left to ASSUME that is what you're RE-collecting from me. One might ask, why did you give it to us, if you're just going to take it back PLUS a few dollars?

When I completed my taxes through TurboTax I was asked if I had received any Covid payments for that tax year (2020). I had not. I received the \$1800 in March of 2021, which is when I cashed the check and used the funds you sent to me electronically. It's easy for you to verify this. Yet now I am being asked to pay that back. Not only that, you asked me to pay back an additional \$3.11, plus I was charged \$35 for the "privilege" of sending the money to you electronically on July 16, 2021, within 30 minutes of receiving your demand. Plus I must pay for this fax (\$4).

In the future, DO NOT SEND ME ANY MORE RELIEF MONEY. I can't afford it.

I have paid the sum of \$1,803.11 per the payment document shown below, at this moment.

You state that if I do not pay this amount by June 28, 2021, you will charge me even more fees, penalties, and who knows what. It takes a month or even two for mail to reach us here in Thailand, and often it doesn't come at all because the Thais think it might be a check and they steal it. Have you ever heard of email? No? Well, TurboTax has heard of it and they use it successfully several million times per day. You could have informed TurboTax of this problem, and they could have, in turn, notified me within minutes. But clearly that is beyond you. No, I will not pay any penalties or fees on this. You can give people time to receive your notifications. But of course you won't. Although you don't (yet) stipulate what fees and penalties I might be liable for, for paying you within 30 minutes of receiving your demand, I am quite happy to go to jail for whatever that amount might be, when you finally get around to assessing it. And let's bring the

media in on it as well. Enough is enough. Everyone has a red line in the sand. This is one of mine. Truly, enough greedy insanity is enough. Seriously. Enough.

In Thailand, Americans are literally, physically dying of Covid, because Thailand won't give us Covid vaccines, and they won't allow expats to pay for vaccines, and they won't allow us to order and import vaccines. Fine and well – that's Thailand. They are quite insane. But they are second to the United States government.

But the US government won't help us with vaccines either. You spout and froth and issue all kinds of flowery written statements to the effect that the US government is doing “everything it can” to bring vaccines to Americans in SE Asia, yet here we are, and as of mid July 2021, **NOT A SINGLE AMERICAN HAS RECEIVED A VACCINE from ANY American source, EXCEPT YOUR EMBASSY STAFFS!**

And you somehow believe that we should keep right on shoveling money to you. In exchange for WHAT?! This is not a rhetorical question. I want an answer. The governments of France, India, Switzerland, the UK, and others, have all physically come to Thailand carrying actual vaccines and fully vaccinated ALL of their citizens here. They did it months ago. Yet not one American has been vaccinated. And you demand that I pay back every penny of Covid relief funds that I received, PLUS MORE?! Are you clinically insane? Or just thieves? Or both?

Again I ask you, FOR WHAT!? For what do expats pay you, when you can't even bring us a vaccine – when you won't even arrange to let us pay for one out of pocket! You won't even bring them to us so we can buy one! And we are dying in droves now because we are all retired and our bodies are weak and sick and highly vulnerable – and we can't get a vaccine. We can't get a vaccine. You do us a profound, stunning, jaw-dropping disservice. You are truly some pieces of work. The proof-of-payment documents, plus your demand document, 2 pages, appear below.

You, ladies and sirs, are killing us. You are taxing us literally, physically, emotionally, psychologically, and spirituality to death. To death. It used to be that you merely taxed us to the point that we wanted to leave this world. Now you are taxing us literally to death. We have nothing left to give you. We have nothing left. And soon, for want of a vaccine, we will not even have our health or our lives.

This is a public post.

We all know you folks will simply chuckle and laugh and shake your heads when you read this because, after all, you get tens of thousands of these per day and you are light-years beyond caring what misery you bring upon the people who sign your paychecks. That's the kind of stuff you're made of. That's why you work where you work. That's the morality you subscribe to and embrace. That is the window to your souls.

So be it.

You've been paid. And paid. And paid again. I have not one more dollar to give you. Most of us left the US and came to Thailand because we simply could no longer afford to live in your country – the place we were born. You take everything we have. Then you give us a little relief. Then you snatch that back with interest. My God, there is something truly wrong with you.

Let me reiterate:

DO NOT EVER SEND ME ANOTHER COVID RELIEF PAYMENT BECAUSE I CANNOT AFFORD TO GIVE IT ALL BACK AT THE END OF THE YEAR PLUS FEES AND INTEREST AND NONSENSE. And my high blood pressure cannot endure the insanity of what you do to us.

Take your Covid payments. Keep them. Put them somewhere dark and smelly, where they belong.
